Project management is viewed as a strategic competence by senior management in an organisation and there is an increasing global demand for skilled project managers. Change is inevitable in any organisation and changes need to be managed effectively for an organisation to remain competitive in the industry. Organisations should lead change by conducting proper project and Programme management. Projects create change and to ensure that projects support the overall business strategy, organisations need project managers with the right set of skills to navigate and drive change. In this module, you will obtain knowledge of project management in an organisational context, including the project management knowledge areas and project management life cycle, the project framework and basic principles and processes related to some of the project management knowledge areas. These include project role players, project coordination and control, project management software, the change control process, project termination and project closure.

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
